Democracy encourages the participation of citizens in matters related to governance and here media plays a crucial role by informing the masses about the various problems plaguing society. In recent times, the Indian media has been subject to a lot of criticism for the manner in which they have disregarded their obligation to social responsibility. In this morbid scenario, the internet as a new media platform presumably stands out as a beacon of independence and transparency.

Internet and concepts like e-governance help create transparency between the government and the citizens. This has made the social platforms a powerful and intimidating tool for public advocacy. Most analysis about social networking tends to focus on the positive qualities and rarely take a negative view. Eventually, a more critical view holds that social media in fact works more against democracy rather than for it. It may lead to mobocracy, where half-baked ideas find emotional resonance with a majority and subsequently force public opinion.

The fact that India has been flooded with more than a billion mobile phones in the last ten years has not made it a deeper or stronger democracy. Technology such as WhatsApp can mobilise people for democratic struggles or even fan violence and hatred.
