4.3. Case Study:

The proposed rule, currently in the draft form, to regulate waste management has changed the definition of hazardous waste & material termed it 'material' & sought to open the countries gates for import of hazardous waste from all over the world for recycling.

As per the draft, if 60 percent of waste is recyclable, then it is not considered waste but 'material' fit for import. Therefore if 60% of computers, in the form of e-waste, can be recycled, then the law permits, the import of e-waste from abroad. Never mind that it brings in toxic like lead, cadmium & mercury present in them.

Draft Hazardous Materials (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement) Rules 2007, were asked released for public comment. International environmental groups got together & alleged the rules would legally turn India into global dump yard.

The key to this allegation is that the rules are not in conformity with the Basel Convention treaty to which India is a signatory.

A member of European Commission, Environment Programme, said, "India is posing to become the global waste picker."
