Q5. Case Study

The proposed rule, currently in the draft, to regulate waste management has changed the definition of hazardous waste and merely termed it 'Material' and sought to open the countries gates for import of hazardous waste from all over the world for recycling.

Draft Hazardous Materials (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2007, were released for public comments; international environmental groups got together and alleged the rules would legally turn India into global dump yard. The key to this allegation is that the rules are not in conformity with the Besel convention treaty to which India is a signatory. A member of European Commission, Environment programme, said,' India is posing to become the global waste picker.
