Due to entrance of new toy brands and increased cost of resources, the company decided to outsource the manufacturing of toys to Chinese companies to reduce the cost. But the toys that came back were coated with toxic lead paint and contained 150 times the legal limit of lead content. The dolls also came with poorly attached parts, like small magnets and accessories, that could perforate the intestines if swallowed.
